DSE CHILDREN EUROPEAN GRAND PRIX (DSE CHEGP)

1. General Rules:

1.1. These rules should be used on any Children European Grand Prix organized under DanceSport Europe (DSE) umbrella.

2. Age groups and Categories:

- 2.1. DSE Children European Grand Prix (DSE CHEGP) are organized for the following:
 - 2.1.1. Juvenile I
 - 2.1.2. Juvenile II
 - 2.1.3. Junior I
 - 2.1.4. Junior II
- 2.2. Some age groups are allowed to compete in competition designated to higher age groups:
 - 2.2.1. Juvenile I can compete also in Juvenile II category
 - 2.2.2. Junior I can compete also in Junior II category

3. Disciplines and Dances:

- 3.1. Standard Dances:
 - 3.1.1. Juveniles groups: Waltz, Tango, Viennese Waltz and Quickstep
 - 3.1.2. Juniors groups: Waltz, Tango, Viennese Waltz, Slow Foxtrot and Quickstep
- 3.2. Latin American Dances:
 - 3.2.1. Juveniles groups: Samba, Cha-Cha-Cha, Rumba and Jive
 - 3.2.2. Juniors groups: Samba, Cha-Cha-Cha, Rumba, Paso Doble and Jive

4. Couples:

- 4.1. All couples who will take part in the DSE CHEGP must be in the possession of an active WDSF competitor licence.
- 4.2. At first start, only no registration is required. The couple must make their registration in WDSF database system until next start in DSE CHEGP. If no registration is done the couple cannot dance and will be excluded form DSE Ranking System

5. Number of Nationalities and Couples:

- 5.1. At least 24 couples from 4 different WDSF member bodies
- 5.2. If less couples are competing deduction of points will be proceeded:
 - 5.2.1. 12 couples from 3 different WDSF member bodies minus 20% of points



- 5.2.2. 6 couples from 2 different WDSF member bodies minus 40% of points
- 5.3. For first year only (2017) there will be no restriction (no deduction of points) about numbers of couple until they will be from at least 2 different WDSF member bodies.
- 5.4. If in any group will be less then 6 couples or they will be from less then 2 different WDSF member bodies two age groups should be connected as follows:
 - 5.4.1. Juvenile I with Juvenile II
 - 5.4.2. Junior I with Junior II

6. Adjudicators:

- 6.1. The panel of 9 adjudicators from 9 different WDSF member bodies or 11 adjudicators from 11 WDSF member bodies must be selected.
- 6.2. All adjudicators must be in the possession of a valid WDSF A licence.
- 6.3. Proposal of Adjudicators panel and Chairperson must be sent in advance to DSE Sport Director at least in one month in advance.
- 6.4. Adjudicators panel and Chairperson must be confirmed by DanceSport Europe Managing Committee.

7. Management of DSE CHEGP Ranking Tournaments:

- 7.1. In all rounds the number of dances should be exactly as its points in rule no 3.
- 7.2. Redance round is obligatory in all categories.
- 7.3. Management of rounds and couples must be exactly like in Appendix 1

8. DSE Ranking Points System:

- 8.1. All couples competing in DSE CHEGP will get the points according to Appendix 2.
- 8.2. DSE Ranking Points System.
- 8.3. The best 3 results of the last 12 moths period will be counted to the DSE Ranking Point System.
- 8.4. The best couples from all age groups will be announced and rewarded during the last DSE CHEGP of the year.

9. Dress Regulations:

9.1. All couples participating DSE CHEGP must follow the WDSF Dress Regulations.



10. Programme Restrictions:

- 10.1. In the Juvenile age groups the programme is limited to Syllabus according to WDSF rules
- 10.2. In the junior age groups, there is no limitation about the dancing programme.

11. Applications:

- 11.1. Applications must be sent 3 months in advance to DSE Sport Director and DSE General Secretary.
- 11.2. DSE can approved later applications in the first (2017) edition

12. Duties and Obligations:

- 12.1. The organizer must include all 4 age group categories of DSE CHEGP.
- 12.2. The organizer must report the results with details of competitors (name, date of birth, country represent, MIN) to DSE Sport Director within 3 days after competition at the latest.
